Gives £25 to his son Joseph.

Gives £25 to his daughter Mary.

Gives to his granddaughter Christian a heifer of two years of age.

Gives 30 shillings to his sister Zenobia.

Gives 2 shillings sixpence to his sister Grace and to her children sixpence each.

The rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his wife Alce** and **his son John**, whom he appoints co-executors of his last will and testament.

An inventory of the goods and chattels of Alexandry Jeffery late of Cury, husbandman, was taken and appraised on 12 Nov 1678 by Henry Marke and Patherick Rashly, and valued to £84 6*s*. 6*d*.

Alexandry died between 11 February and 12 November, 1678. There does not appear to be any surviving copy or bishop's transcript of the Cury parish register for this year. Alexandry's widow, Alce, was buried in Cury on 31 Mar 1694.
