Abstract of the Will of Catherine Lewis of Dolbebin in the Parish of Llanbedr in the County of Merioneth, Widow, written 30 Oct 1827, proved 3 Feb 1829.

Gives and bequeaths £100 to **her grandson John the second son of Morgan Jones of Dolbebin by Elinor his wife**, as well as her clock and corner cupboard.

Gives and bequeaths £80 to **William Jones the eldest son of the above**, as well as her new waistcoat chest.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to **Owen Jones the third son of the above**, as well as her other waistcoat chest.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to **Evan Jones the fourth son of the above**.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to **Edmund Jones the fifth son of the above**.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to **her granddaughter Catherine daughter of the abovenamed Morgan Jones and Elinor his wife**, and her feather bed.

Gives and bequeaths 15 shillings each to Catherine, Lowry, Elinor and Jane the daughters of John David late of Caercethin (deceased) by Jane his wife.

Gives and bequeaths 15 shillings each to Solomon and Margaret children of Robert Jones of Penrallt.

Gives and bequeaths 15 shillings each to William Jones and Thomas Jones the sons of John Williams of Hendrefechan by Elinor Lloyd his wife.

All the rest, residue and remainder of her personal estate she gives and bequeaths to **her son Morgan Jones** whom she nominates, constitutes and appoints sole Executor of her last will and testament.
