Gives and bequeaths £1 to his daughter Margaret Jones the wife of John Owen of Cae llebrith in the Parish of Llanystumdwy, yeoman.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to his son William Jones.

Gives and bequeaths to his son William Jones the two dwelling house called Bryn Gro which stand in the part of the land called  $T\hat{y}$  Newydd Llanystumdwy, with the lease of the said dwelling house for thirty-nine years.

All the rest, residue and remainder of his personal estate and the lease of his dwelling house called Pen y Bont in the Parish of Llanystumdwy he gives and bequeaths to **his daughter Mary Jones** and **his wife Jonet Morris**, nominating, constituting and appointing them sole executrices and administrators of his last will and testament.
