*Abstract of the Will of Rev. John Thomas of Wern in the Parish of Llanfrothen in the County of Merioneth, Rector, written 16 Apr 1803, proved 27 Jun 1803, probate granted 28 Jul 1803.*

Gives and bequeaths 40 shillings to **his eldest son John Thomas**.

Gives and bequeaths 40 shillings to **his eldest daughter Jane Jones the wife of John Jones of Chwillog bâch**.

Gives and bequeaths to **his grandson John the son of his eldest son John Thomas** his share in a vessel called *Endeavour*.

Gives and bequeaths to **his grandson Robert Jones the son of his eldest daughter Jane Jones of Chwillog bâch** his share in a vessel called *The Brothers*.

All the rest, residue and remainder of his personal estate he gives and bequeaths to **his sons and daughters William, Richard, Elizabeth and Mary Thomas**, joint executors of his last will and testament.
