Abstract of the Will of John Wood of the Parish of Wendron in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 3 Apr 1742, proved 22 Sep 1761.

Gives to **his wife Anne** an annuity of £5 during her widowhood as well as the use of the hall and hall chamber with the bedding and furniture in his dwelling at Frenches.

Directs that his executor provides suitable maintenance and upkeep for **his brother Richard Wood** for the term of his natural life.

Gives £10 to his daughter Mary.

Gives £2 2s. to his granddaughter Anne Pryor.

Gives £1 1s. to Mary Thomas his servant-maid.

Gives 1 shilling to his son-in-law Joseph Pryor.

All the rest of his lands and tenements, goods and chattels, rights and credits, he gives to **his son John Wood** whom he appoints sole executor of his last will and testament.

John Wood was christened 7 Aug 1671 in Wendron, son of Richard Wood & Ann Tippet. He was married in Wendron to Ann Tippet in 1695. He was buried in the same parish on 20 May 1748.
