Abstract of the Will of Robert Pontin of Cleevepepper [Clyffe Pypard] in the County of Wilts, Yeoman, written 2 Jan 1717/8, proved 21 May 1718.

Gives and bequeaths 1 shilling to **his son Thomas** and 2 shillings sixpence to **Thomas's wife Sarah** to buy her a pair of gloves.

Gives and bequeaths 1 shilling to his son Joseph.

Gives 5 shillings each to his daughters Elisabeth and Margaret.

Gives £20 to his daughter Isabell if she decides to live by herself.

Gives and bequeaths the rest of his goods and chattels, debts and legacies to **his** wife Margaret and his son Robert, making them joint executors of his last will and testament.

An inventory of the goods and chattels of Robert Pontin late of Cleeve, deceased, was taken on 20 May 1718 by Roger Spackman and Ambrose Tumnell and valued at £129 8s.
