

New South Wales Will Books, 1800-1952, no. 7041.

*Abstract of the Will of Christopher Davis, late of Windsor, Wheelwright, written 24 Oct 1891, probate granted 28 Jun 1894.*

Gives twenty rods of land and the house where he resides in Macquarie Street, Windsor, to his executors, in trust, for the benefit of **his grandson George Henry Davis (son of his son George Davis)** and his heirs.

Gives twenty rods of land and its weatherboard cottage which adjoins the property at Maquarie Street to his executors, in trust, for the benefit of **his grandson Frederick Davis (son of his son Frederick Davis)**, and his heirs.

Gives twenty rods of land with the brick stilling in Macquarie Street aforesaid to his executors, in trust, for the benefit of **Margaret, wife of his son Thomas Davis**, and her heirs.

All the rest of his real and personal estate he gives to **his wife Mary Davis**.

Appoints **his son George Davis** and Mr. John Eggleton of Clarendon, wheelwright, co-executors and trustees of his will.
