Will of William Page Holmes, late of Mudgee, Storekeeper.

THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me WILLIAM PAGE HOLMES of Mudgee, Storekeeper. I appoint **my wife ANNIE AUGUSTA HOLMES** of Mudgee and **my son GEORGE THOMAS HOLMES** of Yamba, Civil Servant, to be the executrix and executor of this my will. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the whole of my property both real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever situate unto my dear wife ANN AUGUSTA HOLMES for the term of her life and at her death I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the same to **my four children ETHEL AUGUSTA BARBER, GRACE HOLMES, ELSIE MAY HOLMES and GEORGE THOMAS HOLMES** in equal shares share and share alike, the share of any daughter who may be married to be held by her as her separate property and free from the control of her present or future husband AS WITNESS my hand at Mudgee this nineteenth day of January A.D. 1922.
