

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/B/6586 W.

Abstract of the Will of Stephen Blight of the Parish of Illogan in the County of Cornwall, Farmer, written 8 Jul 1856, proved 28 Jan 1857.

Gives to **his mother Mary Blight** an annuity of £3 during her natural life.

Gives to **his sister Jemima Blight** an annuity of £12 during the time she remains unmarried. If she marries, then she shall have one fifth of his leasehold estate.

Gives £10 each to **his two brothers and two sisters James Blight and William Blight Ann Jeffery and Jane Gray**.

Gives £40 to **his brother Richard Blight**.

Gives to his **two brothers and two sisters Richard Blight, John Blight, Mary Hambly and Hannah Jeffery**, his leasehold estate with the farm stock, goods, chattels, household furniture and live and dead stock.

Appoints **his brothers Richard Blight and John Blight** co-executors of his last will and testament, in trust, requesting that they assist the family of **his sister Hannah Jeffery**, so long as the amount of assistance does not exceed £100.

All the rest and residue remaining he gives to the said Richard Blight, John Blight, Mary Hambley and Hannah Jeffery.
