

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/C/4312 W.

*Abstract of the Will of Roger Cock of the Parish of Gwithian in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 29 May 1797, proved 17 May 1798.*

Gives to **his son James Cock** an annuity of £5, to be paid out of his premises in Penance in the parish of Gwithian during the lifetime of **his wife Blanch**.

Gives to **his wife Blanch** the remainder of his estates and effects during her life or widowhood. After her death or remarriage, he wills the same to **his two sons, James Cock and Charles Cock**.

Appoints **his wife Blanch** the sole executrix of his last will and testament.
