Abstract of the Will of Roger Cock of the Parish of Gwithian in the County of Cornwall, written 5 Dec 1801, proved 7 Jan 1802.

Gives 10s. 6d. to **his brother John Cock**.

Gives £15 to **his sister Mary Foxwell**.

Gives £20 to **his brother James Cock**, as well as an annuity of £5 out of his estate for as long as the said John Cock lives.

Gives £5 to **his niece Alice Carthew**, to be paid to her when she turns 20.

Gives £5 to his **niece Elizabeth Carthew**, to be paid to her when she turns 20.

Gives £10 to **his nephew Francis Carthew**, to be paid to him when he turns 21.

Gives one guinea of gold to **his aunt Jane Petherick**.

All the rest of his goods, estates and effects he gives to **his brother William Cock** whom he appoints sole executor of his last will and testament.
