Gives £15 to his daughter Mary Clements.

Gives £15 to his daughter Alice Davey.

Gives £15 to his daughter Anne Cock.

Gives to each of his grandchildren a ewe lamb or 2 shillings.

All the rest of his effects and estate he gives to his sons John Cock and Roger Cock, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
