

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/D/2428 W.

Abstract of the Will of Clarinda Davis of the Parish of Probus in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 16 May 1845, proved 11 Jan 1847.

Gives to James Ferris of the borough of Truro in county Cornwall, surgeon, all her stock, implements of husbandry, furniture, life assurances, cash, mortgages, bills, bonds &c., appointing him executor in trust of her will.

Gives to **her son Charles Davis** her leasehold property in Tresillian, subject to the payment of an annuity of £12 to **her son George Davis**.

Directs that the property at Tresillian be subject to the payment of an annual premium of £500 of life assurance upon the life of Mr. Zacharias Roberts in the Imperial Life Assurance Office.

Following the death of Charles she gives the same leasehold property to **her son James Davis**, subject to the payment of £125 life assurance to **her son George Davis** after the death of the said Zacharias Roberts, for the benefit of **her son Peter Davis**.

Directs that **her sons Charles Davis and James Davis** pay to **her daughter Clarinda Davis** an annuity of £5 so long as she remains unmarried.

Directs that her trustee pay to **her daughter Clarinda Davis** the sum of £125 life assurance.

Directs that **her son Peter Davis** pay £100 **her daughter Clarinda Davis**, £50 to **her daughter Jane**, and £50 to **her daughter Ann**.

Direct her trustee pay **her daughter Ann Davis** £125 out of the life assurance.

Gives all her silver spoons marked with the initials A.D. to her son James.

All the rest of her property, goods & chattels she gives to **her son Peter Davis**, subject to the payment of annuity of £10 to **her daughter Clarinda Davis** as long as she remains unmarried.

Effects sworn under £1,500.

Clarinda Oliver, widow, died on 24 Sep 1846 at Tregeagle in Probus, and was buried in Probus on 27 September following.
