Abstract of the Will of John Ellery of the Parish of Redruth in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 5 Feb 1842, proved 27 Aug 1842.

Gives to **his daughter Prudence Pearce** two pictures, one of her likeness, the other of a tiger.

Gives to **Elizabeth Pearce** the (picture of the) woman and child on the parlour chimney.

Gives to **his daughter Ann Gray** two pictures, one of a sheaf and the other of a lion.

Gives to **his four sons Nicholas, Thomas, Joseph and James** all his leasehold property, monies, goods & chattels, in trust.

Gives £6 each to **his daughters Elizabeth and Ann Gray**.

Gives an annuity of £10 to **his daughter Prudence Pearce**.

Gives annuities of £6 each to **his granddaughters Elizabeth and Louisa Ellery, daughters of his son William**.

Appoints **his son Nicholas Ellery** and M^r. Geo: F. Stevens co-executors in trust.

Effects sworn under £200.

John Ellery of Tolgus died on 12 February and was buried on 19 February 1842 in Redruth, Cornwall, aged 83 years.
