Gives £7 to **his son Humphrey**, to be paid when he reaches the age of twenty-four years.

Gives £10 to **his son Francis**, to be paid when he reaches the age of twenty-four years.

Gives £10 to **his son John**, to be paid when he reaches the age of twenty-four years.

Gives £10 to his daughter Katherine.

Gives £10 to his daughter Jane.

Gives £10 to his daughter Ann.

Gives a ewe lamb to his son Henry's daughter.

Gives 3 shillings and 4 pence to the poor of the parish of Camborne.

All the rest of his goods & chattels he gives to **his wife Margaret** along with £10, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
