

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/G/778 W, Inv.

*Abstract of the Will of Ralfe Golsery of the Parish of Gwennap in the County of Cornwall, Tinner, written 17 Oct 1652, proved 26 Jul 1673.*

Gives to **his wife Frances** his tenement called Tolcarne and its dwelling house for the term of her natural life.

Gives to **his son Edward Golsery** that part of the tenement Edward currently lives in, as well as a third part of Raybor Stamps in Tolcarne.

Gives to **his son Ralfe Golsery** the tenement he has of John Haweis and the estate he has of William Trewolla, along with half of the Lower Stamps in Tolcarne.

Gives £20 to **his daughter Elizabeth Golsery**, to be paid to her at her day of marriage or when she turns twenty-one.

Gives to **his brother John Golsery** and his heirs half of the tenement called Releigh in the parish of Crowan.

Gives 10 shillings to **his grandson John Williams**.

Gives 10 shillings to **his daughter Catherine Williams**.

Gives 5 shillings to **Richard Williams**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his granddaughter Frances Williams**.

Gives to **Margarett Williams** the house where her father lives in Tolcarne, passing to the youngest children of **John Williams** after her decease.

Gives 10 shillings to **his sister Paskes Williams**.

All the rest of his goods & chattels he gives to **his sons John Golsery and Collan Golsery**, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.

An inventory of the goods & chattels of Ralfe Golsery late of the parish of Gwennap, deceased, was taken 22 Jun 1673 by Mark Bawden & John Golsery. Total value: £92 0s. 2d.
