Gives half a bushel of barley for tithes forgotten.

Gives to the poor of Gwithian one ewe.

Gives £10 to her son Richard as well as a two-year-old heifer.

Gives to Jane the wife of Paule Jenkins one ewe.

Gives one ewe and one lamb to Alson wife of James Whita and her children.

Gives 12 shillings to [her grandson] John son of Bennet [Harry].

Gives 1 ewe each to [her grandchildren] Jane, Alson and James, children of Bennet [Harry].

Gives her best cloak to Pascas the daughter of Bennet.

Gives a one-year-old calf to the **children of Jane Jenkins**.

Gives 4 pence to each of her godchildren.

Wills to her son Richard her maser cup, after the death of her son Bennet.

Owes to her son Richard 50 shillings.

Owes to **Roger the son of Roger Whita** 25 shillings 4 pence.

Owes £5 to Thomas Thomas.

All the rest of her goods she gives to **her son Bennet**, appointing him sole executor of her last will and testament.
