

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/H/6223 W, Inv.

Abstract of the Will of Nicholas Hocking of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Tinner, written 29 Nov 1747, proved 1 May 1761.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Nicholas Hocking**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Haughton Hocking**.

Gives to **his wife Elizabeth Hocking** an annuity of £4 for the term of her natural life, along with his house and household goods.

Appoints **his son John Hocking** sole executor of his last will and testament.

An inventory of the goods & chattels of Nicholas Hocking of the parish of Camborne, lately deceased, was taken and appraised on 20 Apr 1761 by John Michell and Richard Williams, total value £15 10s. 6d.

Nicholas Hocking was buried in Camborne on 17 Jan 1761.
