

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/18/311.

Abstract of the Will of Walter Kyngdon, Parson of the Parish of St. Martins by Looe in the County of Cornwall and Prebendary of Copynghall in Penkridge in the County of Stafford, written 27 Aug 1515, proved 19 Apr 1516.

Gives 20 shillings each to **John Kyngdon** of Trehunsey and to **John's sister Margery Manaton, children of his brother John Kyngdon.**

Gives 20 shillings each to **John Kyngdon** of Looe, **Edward Kyngdon, Margaret Tregian, Joane Lamylyon** and **Agnes Maynard, sons and daughters of his brother William Kyngdon.**

Gives 20 shillings and his now tenement in East Looe to **Edward Kyngdon** of Fowey, **son of his brother Edward Kyngdon.**

Gives to **his godson Walter Kyngdon, heir of John Kyngdon** of Looe, his other tenement in East Looe.

Gives to **Walter Kyngdon**, Vicar of Lamerton in Devonshire, a silver cup.

Gives to **John Kyngdon** of East Looe a silver cup.

Gives to **Thomas Lamylyon** a gilt cup.

All the rest of his goods gives to the said Walter Kyngdon, vicar of Lamerton, and Edward Kyngdon of Fowey, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
