

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/263/378.

Abstract of the Will of Anthony Manaton of the Parish of St. Pinnock in the County of Cornwall, Minister, written 7 May 1655, proved 21 Apr 1657.

Gives to **his wife Elizabeth Manaton** his best silver bowl and six silver spoons.

Gives to **his son Arthur Manaton** three sheep.

Gives two sheep to **his daughter Joane Greenwood**.

Gives to each of his grandchildren one sheep.

Gives 200 marks to **his daughter Elizabeth Manaton**.

Gives 100 marks to **his daughter Anne Manaton**, as well as the benefit of the Advowson of the Rectory of his benefice of St. Pinnock.

Gives £4 to his unhappy and disobedient daughter **Jane Manaton**.

Appoints **his son Francis Manaton** sole executor of his will.

Nominates **his son Arthur Manaton, Hunt Greenwood, his son-in-law**, and Henrie Spry, gent., overseers of his last will and testament.
