Abstract of the Will of Francis Pascoe of the Parish of Crowan in the County of Cornwall, Tinner, written 29 Jun 1761, proved 8 Nov 1780.

Gives £3 to his daughter Jane Pascoe.

Gives £3 to his daughter Frances Pascoe.

Gives £12 to his son Francis Pascoe, or £6 if he gets married and moves away.

Gives £8 to his son Joseph Pascoe.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his wife Jane Pascoe**, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament, and guardian of the rest of his children. If she re-marries, he gives her £1 1s. only, half of his effects to go to **his son Walter Pascoe** and the other half to **his daughters Grace Pascoe** and **Charity Pascoe**. If his wife re-marries, he appoints instead Melchizedeck Tremaine as guardian of his children.
