Abstract of the Will of Mary Paull the Wife of Richard Paull of the Parish of Illogan in the County of Cornwall, written 28 Feb 1788, proved 16 May 1792.

Gives £5 each to **her sisters Elizabeth the wife of Henry Carpenter and Jane Proviss, widow**, along with all her clothing.

Appoints **her husband Richard Paull** sole executor and residuary legatee of her last will and testament.

Wills that her husband shall hold her estates and effects for life, and that following his death, the same shall become the sole property of **her niece Philippa Tellam** who is currently under the guardianship of the said Henry Carpenter of Illogan, yeoman, and of John Gribbell of the parish of Camborne, schoolmaster, until she turns twenty-one.
