

*Abstract of the Will of Jane Philp of the Parish of St. Kew in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 21 Dec 1765, proved 20 Jun 1766.*

Gives £200 to **her son Samuell Philp**.

Gives to **Honor Philp the wife of her son Francis Philp** a piece of gold worth £3 12s.

Gives to **her grandson Thomas Philp the son of Francis Philp** a silver pint cup and one piece of gold worth £3 12s.

Gives to **her grandson James Reed Philp son of Francis Philp** one piece of gold worth £3 12s.

Gives £10 to **her daughter Joanna Warne** and a silver spoon marked J.J.L.

Gives £30 to **her daughter Margery Philp**, one of two beds, her best round table, her clothing and a silver spoon marked J.L.

Gives £5 to her old servant Ann Boller.

All the rest of her goods and chattels, lands and tenements, she gives to **her son Francis Philp**, whom she appoints sole executor of her last will and testament.
