Gives to **his daughter Ann Simons** £30 as well as £10 to be divided equally between her children.

Gives £20 to his daughter Theadosha Simons.

Gives to his daughter Prudence Prideaux his silver watch.

Gives to **his son Henry** his sixteenth part of the Brig Maria, Nicholas Cundy now master.

Gives £3 to his sister Ann Thomas.

Gives £3 to his sister Mary Clemance.

Gives 1 guinea to Theadosha Hocking.

Gives an annuity of 2 guineas to **Prudence Baker** the elder for the term of her life.

Appoints his sons Henry and John and his two daughters Prudence and Mary Prideaux co-executors of his last will and testament.
