

*Abstract of the Will of Andrew Roswall of the Parish of Towednack in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 9 Oct 1680, proved 23 Nov 1680.*

Gives £20 each to **his six daughters Chesten, Mary, Margrey, Wellmott, Ann and Elizabeth**, to be paid to them after their respective marriages.

Gives £20 to **his sister Mary the wife of Hugh Rosemenewas**.

Gives to **his wife Mary** during her widowhood the profits of his lands which he holds by lease in the parishes of Uny Lelant, St. Just and Towednack.

The remainder of his leasehold lands he gives to his six daughters, share and share alike.

Gives to **his brother James Roswall** all his clothing and gives 12 pence each to his two children.

Gives 12 pence to **his father**.

Gives 10 shillings to the poor of the parish of Towednack.

Gives 10 shillings to Robert Cowch, gent. for making this will.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his wife Mary**, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
