Abstract of the Will of Philip Rowe of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Tinner, written 5 Jul 1757, proved 18 Apr 1777.

Gives to **his wife Elizabeth** all his personal estate, goods & chattels, during her widowhood. If she marries again then gives her instead a horse, a cow, a dozen ewes, and a bed and bedding. After her death he gives the said estate and his household goods to **his sons Philip and William** if they outlive her.

Gives 5 shillings to **his eldest daughter Mary**.

Gives 1 shilling to **his second daughter Elizabeth**.

Gives 1 shilling to **his third daughter Kesiah**.

Gives **his son George** a half share.

Gives to **his fourth daughter Margery** her maintenance during her minority.

No executor named.

An inventory of the goods & chattels of Philip Rowe of the parish of Camborne lately deceased was appraised by John Jeffery and Hugh Reynolds on 25 Jan 1762. Total value: £17 12s. 6d.

Administration was granted to Elizabeth Rowe, the widow and principal.
