

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers,
PROB 11/2209/215.

Abstract of the Will of John Vivian of Pencalenick in the Parish of St. Clement in the County of Cornwall, Esquire, written 29 Aug 1845, proved 24 Mar 1855.

Gives to **his wife Cordelia Vivian** his duchy manor of Morest and lands in the parish of St. Clement, co. Cornwall, the next presentation to the rectory and parish church of Cardinham, and all his personal estate, chattels and effects, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.

(Codicil)

In pursuance of a clause in the Articles of Partnership of Vivian Grylls (and) Kendall of Helston, bankers, he nominates **his eldest son John Vivian Vivian** to be a partner in his place.
