The Will of Richard Whita of the Parish of Gwithian in the County of Cornwall, proved 13 December 1626.

In the name of god the Father the sonne and the holy ghost amen I Richard Whita of the p'ishe of Gwithyan doe make my last will and Testamente unto you in manner and Forme as followeth first I bequeath my soule too lord Jesus Christ

First I give for tieth forgotten xvij^d

I give to the poore mens boxe of Gwithyan v^s

I give to the poore mens boxe of Phelacke ij^s vi^d

I give to **my sonnes daughter Cay** xx^s

I give to **my daughter[s] sonne** xx^s

I give to **my daughter Chesten** a yeow

I give to **my daughter Jenny** a yeow

I give to **Alse Drew** x^s

I give to **my sonne James Whita** xiiij^{li}

I give to my foure servants foure yeowes

I give to Thomas Gayan a heafer of a yeare old

I doe owe James Teage w^{ch} must be payed him vj^{li}

I doe give James Teage a yeow and a lame

All my goods not given I give and bequ[eath] to **Jane my wife** and **Bennat my sonne** I doe ordayne and make my executors
